Smith seconded. All yes votes with Helmick abstaining. Motion carried.

Projects, Buildings and Equipment

Water/Sewer report: Helmick reported curb stop was fixed. Have 2 more to do and one replacement. A Meter will be put in front of fishing station.

Mike McBride reported on an influent sample that will be done on the wastewater by the end of September. An inspection from the State will be done but not sure when yet.

Lead and copper sampling needs to be done September 1. Different residences will be selected to be analyzed for copper. What kind of pipe coming into house or business..copper, PVC etc. State required.

Street Report: Vice reported Gravel was put behind Lyceum. Worked out well.

Riverside Park Report: Vice reported the park is being used a lot. Two grills have been installed at the park.

Old Business:

Steve Woerth wants to board to vote on whether we want to pursue the lease of land to Lyceum for playground. We need to find out if we can legally do it.
